Bletchley Park is home to the origins of modern-day computing and was instrumental in defeating Nazi Germany. Blenheim Palace, home to the Duke of Marlborough and birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill, exudes the beauty and splendour of British aristocracy.

In the afternoon we begin the journey back to Cornwall arriving home in the evening.
