

## Welcome

Thank you for wishing to join our society. We meet for lectures at the Princess Pavilion Falmouth on Fridays from 10.00am, once a month, (apart from July and August), with the lecture beginning at 10.30am. Coffee is available before the lecture from 9.45 am onwards.

We have a programme of 10 Lectures a year plus a number of Special Interest Days and Visits to places of interest. The lectures at the Pavilion are in a theatre, with comfortable tiered seating arranged for members and guests. Facilities include a loop induction system for those with hearing difficulties and a bar/ restaurant for tea and coffee, a drink and lunch.

## New Member Fees

As a new member of **The Arts Society Falmouth** you are required to pay an initial one-off £10 Registration Fee and a prorata Membership Fee. Full membership for the year of 10 lectures is £44 plus £10 registration, giving a total of £54. The table below shows the New Member Fee due, depending upon your date of joining. Two examples: If you were to join on the 15 November 2020, the New Member Fee would be £40.80 (£10 Registration + 7 remaining lectures @ £4.40 each). If you joined on the lecture day itself 13 November 2018 the New Member Fee would be £45.20.

On your payment of the New Member Fee we will send you, by email where possible, a synopsis of the lecture subjects and details of the Society. A Membership Card and a Programme Card with dates of lectures, special interest days and visits will be available for collection at the lectures. (Please note additional charges apply for Special Interest Days and Visits.)
