

## Welcome

Thank you for your interest in joining our Society. We meet for lectures once a month from 10.00am on Fridays, apart from July and August, at the Princess Pavilion in Falmouth, with the lecture beginning at 10.30am. Tea and coffee are available from 9.45 am onwards.

Our programme is ten Lectures a year, plus a number of Discovery Days and Visits to places of interest. Lectures at the Pavilion are in a theatre with comfortable tiered seating for Members and guests. Facilities include a loop induction system for those with hearing difficulties, and a bar and restaurant for light refreshments and lunch.

## New Member Subscriptions

Full membership for the year of 10 lectures is £50. If you join part way through our year you need only pay a pro rata Membership Subscription. Visits and Discovery Days incur an additional cost are run on a break-even basis.

The table below shows the New Member Subscription due, depending upon your date of joining. Two examples: If you were to join on the 15 November 2023, the New Member Subscription would be £35.00 (7 remaining lectures @ £5.00 each). If you joined on the lecture day itself 10 November 2023 the New Member Subscription would be £40.00.

On payment of the New Member Subscription, we will send you, by email where possible, a synopsis of the lecture subjects and details of the Society. A Programme Card with dates of lectures, Discovery Days and visits will be available for collection at the lectures.
